Consistent with SRBA Presiding Judge Barry Wood's Order entered July 14, 2000, the Honorable Roger S. Burdick makes the following disclosure:

1. Honorable Roger S. Burdick's water right interests in the SRBA:
I own and occupy a single residence within the City of Twin Falls. The City supplies all of my domestic water. In addition, I pay a yearly irrigation fee to Twin Falls City for irrigation water which I do not use on my residential lot. I own no other real property in Idaho and neither own nor claim any water rights in Idaho.
2. SRBA water right interests of my family within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity:
My sister, Linda Baker Tylka, resides in Rupert, Idaho, in a single residence within the city limits of Rupert, Idaho. Additionally, she owns a half undivided interest in an undeveloped building lot in Pelican Point Subdivision, Minidoka County. That subdivision has a domestic communal well for property owners within the subdivision. There has been no claim on that water by her.

3. I have no other relatives living in Idaho as my parents live in Denver, Colorado, and my sons live in Alaska and California.
